

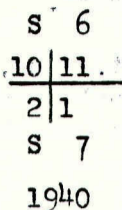

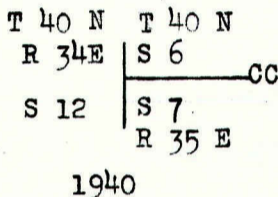

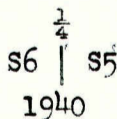

Over nearly level land, thru scattering undergrowth.

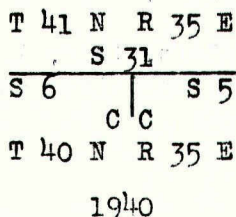
