

T. 40 N., R. 35 E.

General Description.

Township 40 N., R. 35 E., is situated about 45 miles in a north-westerly direction from Winnemucca, Humboldt County, Nevada.

The land varies from mountainous in the eastern to nearly level in the western portions. The soil is a sandy, alkaline clay, 3d rate. There is no timber and but a scattering undergrowth of sagebrush, shadscale and greasewood.

Within section 36, is the Austin Mine, employing about 12 men. Improvements consist of a well of fine water in section 31, an emergency airplane landing field in secs. 30 and 31 and an improved airplane landing field in section 32 and the Austin Mill in sec. 33.

This township is suitable for grazing.
