raise a mound

of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, N. of cor.

- 62.50 Low spur, slopes E.; desc. 30 ft. over a SW. slope.
- 66.80 Draw, drains S. 30° E.; asc. 120 ft. over an E. slope.
- 79.94 The cor. of secs. 17, 18, 19 and 20.

Land, rolling mountainous.  
Soil, sandy, alkaline clay; 3d rate.  
No timber; undergrowth, sagebrush and shadscale.  
Grazing, fair.

West, on true line bet. secs. 18 and 19.

Asc. 300 ft. over mountainous land, on a NE. slope, thru scattering undergrowth.

- 19.60 Draw, drains S. 70° E.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a basalt stone, 6x5x4 ins., mkd. with a cross (X), deposited at base, and in a mound of stone to top, for the ¼ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

- 40.40 Spur, slopes SE.; continue to asc. 40 ft. on top of spur.
- 49.10 Leave top of spur, slopes SE.; desc. 30 ft. over a W. slope.
- 54.50 Draw, drains SE.; asc. 210 ft. over a SE. slope.
- 69.50 Top of ascent, bears N. and S.; desc. 160 ft. over a SW. slope.
- 75.10 Draw, drains SE.; asc. 110 ft. over a SE. slope.
- 80.14 Intersect the Humboldt River Guide Meridian.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a basalt stone, 6x4x4 ins., mkd. with a cross (X), deposited at base, and in a mound of stone to top, for the closing cor. of secs. 18 and 19, with brass cap mkd.
