General Description.

Township 39 N., Range 36 E., is situated in the Awakening Mining District, about 40 miles in a northwesterly direction from Winnemucca, Nevada.

The land varies from nearly level in the E. to rolling mountainous to mountainous in the W. portions. The soil is a sandy, alkaline clay, 3d rate, watered only by rainfall. There is no timber; a scattering undergrowth of sagebrush and shadscale covers the township, affording only fair grazing.

There is much mining activity in the western part of the township; there will be found the Alabama, Ellison and Siskyou mines; and prospect holes in great numbers are found in secs. 6, 7 and 18. These mines employ about 30 men.

Mining is the only occupation pursued.
