- 15.00 Draw, drains N. 80° E.; asc. 80 ft. over a S. slope.
- 21.00 Point of spur, slopes S. 10° E.; desc. 90 ft. over a N. slope.
- 25.00 Draw, drains S. 70° E.; asc. 170 ft. over a S. slope.
- 33.70 Spur, slopes N. 70° E.; desc. 420 ft. over a N. slope.
