Chains

At cor. point

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with the original cor. deposited at base, for standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with the original cor. deposited at base, for standard cor. of secs. 31 and 32, with brass cap mkd.
