for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

raise a mound

of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, W. of cor.

43.50 Draw, drains NE.; asc. 30 ft. over a SE. slope.

50.00 Top of ascent, bears E. and W.; desc. slightly over a NE. slope.

70.00 Foot of descent, bears E. and W.; asc. 20 ft. over a SE. slope.

80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, for the cor. of lots 1, 4, 5 and 8, with brass cap mkd.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, from the closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd.

From this point the standard cor. of secs. 31 and 32, bears East, 6.17 chs. dist.; an iron post, 3 ins. diam., 12 ins. above ground, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record.

At midpoint bet. the closing cors. on the N. bdy. of sec. 2,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground,
