

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF PORTION OF SUBDIVISIONAL LINES, T. 4 S., R. 36 E.

Chains

Land, nearly level, drains northeasterly.
Soil, sandy and gravelly.
Undergrowth, light sagebrush, and desert growth.
Grazing, poor.

N. 89° 52' E., bet. secs. 26 and 35.

Descend 70 ft. over gradual NE. slope, through light brush.

13.70 Old scraped highway, bears NW. and SE.

19.40 Oiled state highway, bears N. 33½° W. to Nevada State Highway No. 3A and S. 33½° E. to Oasis.

37.38 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary.

Point for closing cor. of secs. 26 and 35.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

Raise a flat mound of stone, 3 ft. base, around post to top.

From this point the 1 mile cor. from Monument No. 71 bears S. 47° 31' E., 19.16 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the portion of the California-Nevada State Boundary resurveyed under this assignment.

Continue measurement on blank line bet. former secs. 26 and 35.

40.45 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 26 and 35, at proportionate distance, find no evidence of the original corner.

54.50 Scraped road, bears N. 10° E. and S. 10° W. to highway.

80.90 Cor. No. 2 of Tract 38; the former cor. of secs. 25, 26, 35, and 36.

Land, gentle NE. slope of Fish Lake Valley.
Soil, sandy and gravelly alkaline clayloam.
Undergrowth, light sagebrush, soapweed and greasewood.
Grazing, poor.

From the cor. of secs. 26, 27, 34, and 35.

N. 0° 03' W., bet. secs. 26 and 27.

Descend 45 ft. on gradual NE. slope, through light undergrowth.

12.00 Rut road, bears N. 85° W. and E. to highway.

18.20 Old scraped highway, bears NW. and SE.

22.00 Rut road, bears S. 60° W. and N. 85° E. to highway.

27.00 Oiled State Highway, bears N. 33½° W. and S. 33½° E.

34.81 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary.

Point for the closing corner of secs. 26 and 27.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked
