



DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF PORTION OF SUBDIVISIONAL LINES, T. 4 S., R. 36 E.

Chains	<p>Descend 90 ft. over gradual NE. slope, through light undergrowth.</p> <p>30.60 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary.</p> <p>Point for closing cor. of secs. 22 and 27.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Raise a flat mound of stone, 4 ft. base around post to top.</p> <p>From this point Monument No. 70 bears N. 47° 28.4' W., 7.355 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the portion of the California-Nevada State Boundary resurveyed under this assignment.</p> <p>Continue measurement on blank line, bet. former secs. 22 and 27.</p> <p>36.20 Old scraped highway, not in present use, bears NW. and SE.</p> <p>40.40 The original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 22 and 27, evidenced by an embedded mound of stone. Alongside is the remains of the original cottonwood post, 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. long, 2 ins. diam., marked $\frac{1}{4}$ on one smoothed side.</p> <p>I remove all evidence of this corner.</p> <hr style="width: 20%; margin: 10px auto;"/> <p>S. 89° 56' E., beginning new measurement, on blank line.</p> <p>40.45 Point for the former cor. of secs. 22, 23, 26, and 27.</p> <p>Land, rolling and washed NE. slope in Fish Lake Valley. Soil, sand, gravel, and rock. Undergrowth, very light sagebrush and desert growth. Grazing, poor.</p>
28.62	<p>From the cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28.</p> <p>N. 1° 11' W., bet. secs. 21 and 22.</p> <p>Descend 65 ft. over gradual washed NE. slope, through light brush.</p> <p>Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary.</p> <p>Point for closing cor. of secs. 21 and 22.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked</p> <div style="text-align: center;">  </div> <p>Raise a flat mound of stone, 4 ft. base, around post to top.</p>
