

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF PORTION OF SUBDIVISIONAL LINES, T. 4 S., R. 36 E.

Chains

From this point the $\frac{1}{2}$ mile cor. from Monument No. 69 bears S. $47^{\circ} 31'$ E., 8.83 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the portion of the California-Nevada State Boundary resurveyed under this assignment.

Continue measurement on blank line bet. former secs. 21 and 22.

39.81 Point for the $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. of secs. 21 and 22 at proportionate distance. Find no evidence of the original cor.

79.62 Point for the cor. of secs. 15, 16, 21, and 22, at proportionate distance. Find no evidence of the original corner.

This now becomes the point for Cor. No. 5 of Tract 37, only.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, around post.

From this point:

Point for former closing cor. of secs. 15 and 22 on the Von Schmidt State Line bears S. $89^{\circ} 37'$ E., 15.60 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the portion of the Von Schmidt State Line retraced under this assignment.

The original $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. of secs. 16 and 21 bears N. $88^{\circ} 19'$ W., 38.93 chs. dist.; hereinafter described.

Cor. No. 6 of Tract 37, at point for former closing cor. of secs. 15 and 16 on the Von Schmidt State Line bears N. $3^{\circ} 11'$ W., 14.75 chs. dist.; described in the field notes of the portion of the Von Schmidt State line retraced under this assignment.

Land, washed, gradual NE. slope in Fish Lake Valley.
Soil, sand, gravel and rocks.
Undergrowth, very light sagebrush and desert growth.
Grazing, poor.

From the cor. of secs. 21, 22, 27, and 28.

N. $89^{\circ} 32'$ W., bet. secs. 21 and 28.

Ascend 90 ft. over gradual NE. slope, through light undergrowth.

38.10 Wash, 20 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, course N. 5° E.

40.64 The $\frac{1}{2}$ sec. cor. of secs. 21 and 28, evidenced by the stub of the original cottonwood stake in the center of an embedded mound of stone, 3 ft. base, and 1 ft. high.

At the corner point

Set a granite rock, 22x12x6 ins., 8 ins. in the ground, marked $\frac{1}{2}$ on N. side, and raise a flat mound of stone 4 ft. base, 1 ft. high, around the rock, with stub of original post deposited alongside.

S. $89^{\circ} 56'$ W., beginning new measurement.
