

DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF PORTION OF SUBDIVISIONAL LINES, T. 5 S., R. 37 E.

Chains

Deposit the length of mine rail track alongside the iron post and raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, around post to top.

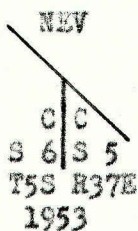
N. 0° 07' W., beginning new measurement.

Descend 30 ft. over gradual NE. slope.

30.51 Intersect the California-Nevada State Boundary line.

Point for closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap marked



Raise a flat mound of stone, 3 ft. base, around post to top.

From the point ^{this} the 2½ mile cor. from Mon. No. 71 bears S. 47° 31' E., 6.36 chs. dist.

Continue line and measurement on blank line bet. ^{former} former secs. 5 and 6.

39.50 The former cor. of secs. 5 and 6, on N. bdy. of Tp.; now an angle point on the S. bdy. of Tract 38.

Land, nearly level, gentle NE. slope of Fish Lake Valley.
Soil, alkaline clayloam and sand, 2d rate.
Undergrowth, light sagebrush and desert growth.
Grazing, poor.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land in the portion of Township 5 South, Range 37 East resurveyed under this assignment lies in the floor of Fish Lake Valley and is nearly level or level. Elevation is about 5000 ft. above sea level.

The soil is alkaline clayloam and sand, with some gravel, generally about 2d rate.

The undergrowth is light and consists principally of sagebrush with some greasewood, soapweed and other desert growth. Grasses are scarce and grazing is poor.

There are wells and windmills in secs. 5 and 8, and a well and windmill in sec. 1 of T. 5 S., R. 36 E.

An oiled highway through secs. 6, 7, and 8, bears N. 33½° W. to Nevada State Highway No. 3A and S. 33½° E. to Oasis where it joins the road between Lida and Lone Pine.
