7.70	Top of spur, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 35 ft.										
9.50	Wash, course N.; asc. 100 ft.										
19.10	Top of ridge, bears NW. and SE.; desc. 70 ft.										
24.30	Hillside drain, course N.; asc. 10 ft.										
26.20	Top of spur, slopes N.; desc. 40 ft.										
31.20	Wash, 50 lks. wide, course N.10°W.; asc. 15 ft.

SURVEY OF THE S. BDY. OF T. 8 N., R. 43 E.

Beginning at the reestablished cor. of secs. 31 and 32 on the S. bdy. of T. 8 N., R. 43 E.,

East, on a random line along the S. bdy. of T. 8 N., R. 43 E., setting temporary $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. and sec. cors. at intervals of 40.00 chs., and at 398.43 chs., intersect the W. bdy. of T. 8 N., R. 44 E., 5.37 chs. N. of the reestablished cor. of Ts. 7 and 8 N., R. 44 E.

At the point of intersection,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for cor. of Ts. 7 and 8 N., R. 43 E., with brass cap mkd.
