


SUBDIVISION OF T. 7 N., R. 43 E.

- Chains
 58.40 Unimproved road, bears E. and W.
 59.20 Large wash, 30 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, course W.; asc. 20 ft. over SW. slope.
 68.10 Point of spur, projects W.; desc. 15 ft.
 72.80 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 3 ft. deep, course W.; asc. 65 ft. over SE. slope.
 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone to top, for cor. of lots 4-5 of sec. 3 and lots 1-8 of sec. 4, with brass cap mkd.



from which,


- A piñon pine, 3 ins. diam., bears N.75 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 139 lks. dist., mkd. BT.
- A juniper, 3 ins. diam., bears N.66 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W., 180 lks. dist., mkd. BT.

Asc. 25 ft. over SE. slope.

86.04 Intersect the S. bdy. of T. 8 N., R. 43 E.

At point of intersection,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 7 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a large mound of stone to top, for closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4, with brass cap mkd.



from which,

- A juniper, 10 ins. diam., bears S.57°E., 308 lks. dist., mkd. T7N R43E S3 CC BT.
- A piñon pine, 14 ins. diam., bears S.66°W., 236 lks. dist., mkd. T7N R43E S4 CC BT.

From this cor., the cor. of secs. 33 and 34 on the S. bdy. of T. 8 N., R. 43 E., bears East, 4.06 chs. dist.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, sandy, gravelly and rocky; 4th rate.

Timber, piñon pine and juniper; undergrowth, sagebrush and a fair growth of grass.

At midpoint on the N. bdy. of sec. 3,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 5 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a granite stone, 5x5x6 ins., mkd. with a cross (X) deposited at the base and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
