## Chains

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 10 ins. in the ground to bedrock, and supported in a mound of stone to top, for witness cor. for cor. of secs. 1 and 2, T. 9 N., R. 45 E. only, with brass cap mkd.

A pinon pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S.  $53\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E., 12 lks. dist., mkd. T 9 N R 45 E S 1 WC BT.

A pinon pine, 12 ins. diam., bears S.  $59^{\circ}$  W., 48 lks. dist., mkd. T 9 N R 45 E S 2 WC BT.

Land, mountainous, except a narrow strip of about 10.00 chs. along Meadow Canyon.

Soil, sandy, gravelly and very rocky; except the floor of Meadow Canyon which is sandy loam.

Timber, scattering pinon pine and juniper; undergrowth, sagebrush, greasewood and willows. Grazing, good.

## Survey of the South Boundary of T. 10 N., R. 45 E.

From the true point for the original cor. of secs. 1, 2, 35, and 36, on the S. bdy. of T. 10 N., R. 45 E., which now refers only to secs. 1 and 2, on the N. bdy. of T. 9 N., R. 45 E., and is 76.91 chs. in departure from the cor. of Tps. 9 and 10 N., Rs. 45 and 46 E.

West, along S. bdy. of sec. 36.

Asc. 55 ft. over NE. slope, through scattering timber and dense undergrowth.
