

Survey of the West Boundary of T. 9 N., R. 45 E.

Chains	
49.25	Top of high divide ridge, bears N. 70° W. and S. 80° E.; desc. 65 ft. over N. slope.
59.20	Ravine, with a small stream, 1 lk. wide, ½ in. deep, course S. 80° E.; asc. 165 ft. over S. slope.
72.00	Top of spur, slopes S. 50° E.; desc. 20 ft. over N. slope.
75.75	The cor. of Tps. 9 and 10 N., R. 45 E.

Land, mountainous.  
 Soil, sandy, shallow, gravelly and rocky; 4th rate.  
 Timber, pinon pine, juniper and mahogany and a few small scattering groves of aspen; undergrowth, sagebrush.  
 Grazing, good.

Dependent Resurvey of Subdivisions of T. 9 N., R. 45 E.

Reestablishment of surveys executed by Don H. Barker, Deputy Surveyor, in 1874.

Beginning at the reestablished cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34, and 35, on the S. bdy. of the tp., which is monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., 9 ins. above ground, firmly set; mkd. and witnessed as described in the survey of T. 8 N., R. 45 E.



Over rolling mountainous land, through scattering timber, and dense undergrowth, desc. 10 ft. over a general NW. slope.

4.20	Wash, 5 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course W.; desc. 10 ft.
7.00	Wash, 5 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course W.; desc. gradually.
13.50	Wash, 5 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course W.; desc. 50 ft.
34.30	Wash, 10 lks. wide, 1 ft. deep, course N. 75° W.; asc. 15 ft.
39.88	Proportionate point.
