10.90	Top of crag, projects SW.; desc. 220 ft. over series of small ledges, crags and large boulders, along a W. slope.
26.00	Top of divide ridge, bears N. 75° W. and S. 75° E. 2.00 chs., thence S. 20° E.; desc. 210 ft. over rocky N. slope.
40.00	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.

	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 5 and 6, with brass cap mkd.

	of stone, 2 ft. base, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. high, S. of cor.
	From this closing sec. cor., the cor. of secs. 31 and 32, T. 10 N., R. 45 E., bears East, 8.81 chs. dist.
	Land, mountainous. Soil, sandy, gravelly and rocky; 4th rate. Timber, mahogany, pinon pine and juniper; undergrowth, sagebrush. Grazing, good.
	At midpoint on the N. bdy. of sec. 5.
	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with a granite stone, 5x6x8 ins., mkd. with a cross (x), deposited at the base, and in a mound of stone to top, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 5 only, with brass cap mkd.
