A juniper, 13 ins. diam., bears S. 27° E., 86 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S3 BT.

40.00 Point for the E. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 4.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground,
with brass cap mkd.

61.50 Crest of rocky outcroppings, project W.; asc. 70 ft. along W. slope.

75.90 Crest of spur ridge, bears NW. and S. 30° E.; asc. 15 ft.79.28 Intersect the N. bdy. of the township, on the S. bdy. of sec. 33,
T. 14 N., R. 58 E., at point for closing cor. of secs. 3 and 4.

described.

Land, rough rugged mountainous.

Soil, light sandy loam, very shallow, mostly limestone ledges,
crags and outcroppings, with considerable talus over the surface.
Timber, mahogany, pinon and juniper, alpine fir, balsam fir and
foxtail pine; undergrowth, sagebrush, laurel, buckbrush, brierbrush
and a fair growth of grass.
