

## Survey of a Portion of the Subdivision of T. 13 N., R. 58 E.

Chains

34.30 Gulch, course S. 60° W.; asc. 10 ft. along W. slope.

38.00 Spur, slopes SW.; desc. 10 ft. along W. slope.

40.00 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 12 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with brass cap mkd.

A pinon, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 54° E., 30 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S4 BT.A pinon, 24 ins. diam., bears S. 16° W., 14 lks. dist., mkd.  $\frac{1}{4}$  S5 BT.

Desc. 180 ft. over NW. slope.

49.90 Gulch, course S. 60° W.; asc. 110 ft. over S. slope.

57.70 Spur, projects N. 80° W.; desc. 140 ft. over NW. slope.

71.80 Ravine, course S. 30° W. from E.; asc. 95 ft. over SE. slope to closing cor.

73.50 Graded road, bears S. 30° W. and for 1.00 chs. N. 30° E. to end of same; thence a trail winds northerly into the mountains.

78.08 Intersect the N. bdy. of the township, on the S. bdy. of sec. 32, T. 14 N., R. 58 E., at point for closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

A pinon, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 74  $\frac{3}{4}$ ° E., 242 lks. dist., mkd. T13N R58E S4 CC BT.

A pinon, 6 ins. diam., bears S. 74° W., 222 lks. dist., mkd. T13N R58E S5 CC BT.

From this cor., the reestablished cor. of secs. 32 and 33, T. 14 N., R. 58 E., bears N. 89° 04' E., 2.01 chs. dist., hereinbefore described.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, light sandy clay loam, gravelly and rocky.

Timber, pinon, juniper and mahogany; undergrowth, sagebrush, snowbrush, buckbrush, laurel and a fair growth of grass.

At the point for the N.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 4 and at midpoint on the N. bdy. of the section.
