

## Dependent Resurvey, East Boundary, T. 13 N., R. 56 E.

Point for the cor. of secs. 1 and 12, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of cor.

Land, rolling mountainous.

Soil, light sandy clay loam, medium texture, gravelly and rocky. Timber, none; undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale, greasewood, and a fair growth of grass.

N.  $0^{\circ}$  15' E., along the E. bdy. of sec. 1.

Desc. very gradually over nearly level land, through dense undergrowth.

4.90 Ravine, 10 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, course S.  $25^{\circ}$  W. Leave nearly level land; asc. 40 ft. over rolling mountainous land, sloping generally S.

40.185 Point for the E.  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 1, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 25 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with brass cap mkd.

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Raise a supporting mound of stone,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ft. base, 1 ft. high, around the iron post, and raise an auxiliary mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, W. of cor.

Corner is situated on crest of a broad flat spur, sloping S.  $30^{\circ}$  W.

Asc. 50 ft. over gradual SW. and W. slopes.

80.37 Point for the cor. of Ts. 13 and 14 N., R. 56 E., at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
