From this closing cor., the reestablished cor. of Ts. 12 and 13 N., R. 56 E., bears N. 0° 43' W., 9.86 chs. dist. This cor. is described in the field notes of the dependent resurvey of a portion of the E. bdy. of T. 12 N., R. 56 E., executed concurrently under this same survey group.

Land, rolling mountainous and nearly level bottom land. Soil, light sandy clay loam, medium texture, dry, rocky and gravelly on the mountainous land; soil of the bottom land is a fine sandy alluvial adobe, alkaline. Timber, none; undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale, greasewood, rabbit brush, and a fair growth of grass.
