Chains	Desc. 30 ft. over bench land sloping gradually to SW.
80.00	Point for the cor. of lots 14 and 15, sec. 6, and of lots 2 and 3, sec. 7.
	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

	Land, rolling desert valley. Soil, light sandy clay loam, medium texture, gravelly and rocky. Timber, none; undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale, greasewood, rabbit brush, jointbrush, and a fair growth of grass.
	At the point for the W. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 7 and at midpoint on the W. bdy. of sec. 7.
	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 16 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with brass cap mkd.

	Raise a supporting mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 20 ins. high, around the iron post.

	At the point for the W. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 6, and 40.00 chs. in northing from the closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7.
	Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
