

## GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land within T. 45 N., R. 67 E. is generally rolling in character with rolling hills along the north boundary and in the southeast quarter of the township.

The open rolling major portion of the township is covered with a relatively low but dense growth of sage brush, with considerable grass, affording stock range from fairly poor in the lower areas in the south and east portions of the township which have little grass to good range in the higher northwest portion of the township where there is a good stand of grass. There is little or no water in the major portion of the township; however there is an excellent spring in the SE. quarter of sec. 6, and stock water is available seasonally along the west boundary of the township.

There is a considerable but scattered growth of juniper trees in the southeast part of the township and along the eastern part of the north boundary, which affords firewood and fence posts.

There is no settlement within the township.
