Chains	<p>Land, rough broken mountainous. Soil, light shallow sandy loam, medium texture, mixed with a heavy deposit of gravel on a clay and limestone base. Also with many limestone outcroppings; 3rd rate. Timber, juniper, pinon pine and mahogany. Undergrowth, sagebrush, buckbrush and a good stand of various native grasses. Grazing, good.</p>

	<p>Preliminary to the survey of the South Boundary of T. 14 N., R. 68 E., I commence at the original cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31, and 32, on the N. bdy. of T. 13 N., R. 68 E., which is a slate stone, 24x10x6 ins., firmly set in a mound of stone, mkd. with 5 grooves on E. and 1 groove on W. faces.</p> <p>Thence</p> <p>East, on a random line 393.42 chs. to a point of intersection with a line extended South, 45.61 chs. from the cor. of Tps. 13 and 14 N., Rs. 68 and 69 E., which was established in 1921, under surveys of Group 95.</p>
