Timber, pinon pine, juniper and mahogany.

Undergrowth, sagebrush and grass. Grazing, good.

At midpoint on the W. bdy. of sec. 31,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to bedrock and in a mound of stone, for ¼ sec. cor. for sec. 31, with brass cap mkd.
