

Subdivision of T. 14 N., R. 68 E.

Chains

A pinon pine, 6 ins. diam., bears N. $71\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 191 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 19 BT.

Entrance to mine drift, extending N. 10° E., bears S. 80° W., 60 lks. dist.

41.00 Top of spur ridge, bears NE. and SW.; desc. 240 ft. over SW. slope.

48.80 Trail, bears N. and S.; desc. 140 ft.

53.20 Trail, bears N. 15° W. and S. 15° E.; desc. 245 ft.

64.60 Ravine, course S. 15° W.; asc. 60 ft.

74.74 Intersect the E. bdy. of T. 14 N., R. 67 E.

At point of intersection,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for closing cor. of secs. 19 and 30, with brass cap. mkd.

A pinon pine, 12 ins. diam., bears N. $17\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 73 lks. dist., mkd. T 14 N R. 68 E S 19 CC BT.

A pinon pine, 4 ins. diam., bears S. $28\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 53 lks. dist., mkd. only CC BT.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, shallow, sand and coarse gravel, sliderock and outcropping.

Timber, mahogany and pinon pine.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, buckbrush, jointbrush and grass.

Grazing, good.

At midpoint on the W. bdy. of sec. 30,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 27 ins. in the ground, for $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. for sec. 30, with brass cap mkd.
