At the above mentioned deflection point, I properly establish a true meridian and every 30 minutes from 9:00 to 10:30 a.m. and from 1:30 to 6:00 p.m., I make proper settings on the arcs of the solar attachment and ascertain that the resulting orientation of the instrument, when compared with the true meridian, has a maximum error of less than 1' 30". I therefore conclude that the instrument is in satisfactory adjustment.

I repeat the tests of the arcs daily by noon observation and verify the meridional indications at frequent intervals throughout the survey.
