

## Survey of the Subdivision of Fractional T. 15 N., R. 71 E.

Chains

From the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, on the W. bdy. of the township, described in the field notes of the East Boundary of T. 15 N., R. 70 E., this group.

East, bet. secs. 6 and 7.

Desc. 140 ft. abruptly over rough broken land, on a SE. slope, over broken cliffs, through scattering undergrowth.

5.00 Foot of cliff, bears NE. and SW.; leave rough broken land, enter rolling land; desc. 40 ft. over an E. slope.

22.50 Unimproved road, bears NW. and SE.

31.70 Shallow wash, course S. 60° E.

35.98 Intersect the Utah-Nevada State Boundary, at point for closing cor. of secs. 6 and 7.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

From this closing corner, State Line Mile Post No. 148, bears S. 0° 06' W., 21.58 chs. dist.

Land, rough mountainous and rolling.

Soil, gravelly, rocky clay.

No timber; undergrowth, greasewood.

At the point for the E. ¼ sec. cor. of sec. 7, on the Utah-Nevada State Line, and midpoint between the NE. and SE. corners of the section.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 1½ ft. high, W. of cor.

From this corner, Mile Post No. 148 on the Utah-Nevada State Line, bears N. 0° 05' E., 18.41 chs. dist.

#### General Description

Township 15 North, Range 71 East is situated northeast, about 12 miles distant from Baker, White Pine County, Nevada. Its east boundary is the Utah-Nevada State Boundary. The southeast corner of the township has an approximate elevation of 5070 ft. above sea level.
