Chains	<p>From the point for corner</p> <p>A local corner, a juniper post, 3 ins. diam., 18 ins. long, located 10 lks. S. of a fence corner, from which fences bear E. and N., bears N. 08° 57' W., 11.60 chs. dist.</p> <p>80.22 The corner of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, marked by a juniper post, 2 ins. square, 2½ ft. high, mkd. 	<p>General Description</p> <p>The land in this township is nearly level desert, with sandy and gravelly to sandy clay soil. There is no timber, and the township is covered with a general growth of sagebrush.</p>
