

## North Edy., T. 9 N., R. 61 E.

## Chains

80.22 The cor. of secs. 4, 5, 32 and 33, marked by a juniper post, 2 ins. square, loosely set in an old mound of earth, and mkd. SXXXIII on NW. side with illegible marks on other three sides.

At the corner point

Reset the old post, 12 ins. in the ground, with a juniper post, 5 ins. diam., at the base, 6 ft. long, set alongside.

S. 89° 50' W., bet. secs. 5 and 32.

40.29 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 5 and 32, at proportionate distance; the remains of the original corner monument, a part of the old marked post, was found lying loose on the ground nearby. There is no remaining evidence of the original position of this post. Corner not monumented.

80.58 The cor. of secs. 5, 6, 31 and 32, marked by a juniper post, 3 ins. diam., 16 ins. above ground, no marks legible, firmly set in the ground.

Set a juniper post, 4 ins. diam., 6 ft. high, alongside the old post.

N. 88° 49' W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.

39.56 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Corner not monumented.

65.60 Graded road, bears NE. and SW.

76.64 The cor. of Ts. 9 and 10 N., Rs. 60 and 61 E.

## General Description

The land in T. 9 N., R. 61 E. is nearly level desert, with sandy clay soil. There is no timber in this township. There is a general covering of sagebrush.
