

Dependent Resurvey, West Boundary, T. 10 N., R. 61 E.

Chains

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long,  $2\frac{1}{2}$  ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, with a rock, 10x8x4 ins., mkd. X, deposited at the base, with brass cap mkd.

Dig a trench, 5 ft. diam., and raise a mound of earth, 3 ft. diam., around corner.

From this corner

The standard corner of T. 11 N., Rs. 60 and 61 E., monumented with an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, bears East, 10.85 chs. dist.

The standard  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of sec. 36, monumented with an iron post, 1 in. diam., set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the official record, bears West, 29.15 chs. dist.

Land, nearly level.  
Soil, clay.  
No timber; undergrowth, sagebrush.

General Description
