A pinon, 10 ins. diam., bears S. $32\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ E., 56 lks. dist., mkd. T13N R60E S5 BT.A juniper, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 45° W., 50 lks. dist., mkd. T13N R60E S6 BT.A pine, 6 ins. diam., bears N. 13° E., 37 lks. dist., mkd. BT.A cabin, bears S. 76° $10'$ W., approximately 35 chs. dist.

Soil, sandy and gravelly to rocky.
