87.11	Intersect the S. bdy. of sec. 36, T. 15 N., R. 61 E. Point for the closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. T15N R61E S36 S2S1 C C T14N R61E 1953 Raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. diam., around the iron post to top. from which A juniper, 6 ins. diam., bears S. $31\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 22 lks. dist., mkd. T14N R61E S1 CC BT. A juniper, 8 ins. diam., bears S. $65\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 100 lks. dist., mkd. T14N R61E S2 CC BT. The cor. of secs. 35 and 36, T. 15 N., R. 61 E., bears West, 2.44 chs. dist. Land, nearly level to rolling desert. Soil, sandy to rocky. Timber, scattering juniper and pinon; undergrowth, sagebrush, black brush and rabbit brush.
	At the point for the N. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1, 40 chs. E. of the NW. cor. of the sec. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock, with brass cap mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 1 1953 from which A juniper, 7 ins. diam., bears S. $57\frac{1}{4}^{\circ}$ E., 122 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S1 BT. A juniper, 12 ins. diam., bears S. $34\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 181 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S1 BT. The S. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36, T. 15 N., R. 61 E., bears West, 2.44 chs. dist.
	The cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35. on the S. bdy. of the township is monumented with an iron post, 2 ins. diam., firmly set, mkd. and witnessed as described in the record of the Independent Resurvey of the N. bdy. of T. 13 N., R. 61 E. N. 0° 01' W., bet. secs. 34 and 35. Over rolling to broken land, through scattering timber and low undergrowth; asc. 30 ft. over SW. slope.
7.95	Spur, slopes W.; desc. 10 ft. along W. slope.
12.15	Ravine, 10 lks. wide, 18 ins. deep, drains W.; asc. 30 ft. over SW. slope.
