10.40	Spur, slopes E.; desc. 75 ft. over N. slope.
15.75	Wash, near head, 10 lks. wide, 18 ins. deep, drains N. 85° E. Asc. 20 ft. over S. slope.
28.60	Spur, slopes NE.; desc. 20 ft. over N. slope.
40.00	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock, with brass cap mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 5 S 4 1953 from which A juniper, 8 ins. diam., bears N. 89° E.. 49 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S4 BT. Raise a mound of stone, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 12 ins. high, around the iron post. Desc. 10 ft. over very gradual N. slope.
47.00	Dirt road, bears E. and W.
52.00	Jake's Wash, 50 lks. wide, 4 ft. deep, drains E.; asc. 40 ft. over S. slope.
64.00	Spur ridge, bears N. 85° W. and S. 85° E.; desc. 130 ft. over NE. slope.
79.10	Dirt road, bears E. and W.
80.00	Point for the $\frac{1}{16}$ sec. cor. of secs. 4 and 5. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd. $\frac{1}{16}$ S 5 S 4 80 1953 Deposit a pint pop bottle alongside and raise a mound of stone, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 8 ins. high, around the iron post.
80.20	Wash, 15 lks. wide, 10 ft. deep, drains E.; asc. 40 ft. over S. slope.
86.48	Intersect the S. bdy. of sec. 33, T. 15 N., R. 61 E. Point for the closing cor. of secs. 4 and 5. Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 18 ins. in the ground to solid rock, with brass cap mkd. T15N R61E S33 S5 S4 C C T14N R61E 1953 from which
