along a Portion of the South Boundary of T. 16 N., R. 59 E.

	<p>Reset the old juniper post alongside and set a new juniper post, 4 ins. square, 4 ft. long alongside and raise a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, 8 ins. high, around the iron post.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">-----</p> <p>S. 89° 36' W., beginning new measurement.</p>
36.40	Leave undergrowth; thence over cleared area overgrown with grasses.
40.20	Point for the standard corner of secs. 35 and 36, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Corner not reestablished.
	<p>Land, gently rolling. Soil, sandy and gravelly to alkaline clay. No timber; undergrowth, sagebrush, black brush, rabbit brush and salt grass.</p>
	<p>S. 89° 36' W., on the S. bdy. of sec. 35.</p> <p>Over gently rolling land, through low undergrowth.</p>
11.00	Wash, 5 lks. wide, 2 ft. deep, drains N. 60° E.
23.20	Leave cleared land, bears SE. and NW.; reenter undergrowth.
24.80	Branch of same wash, 5 lks. wide, $1\frac{1}{2}$ ft. deep, drains SE.
40.20	Point for the standard $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 35, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner. Corner not reestablished.
80.40	<p>The original standard corner of secs. 34 and 35, marked by a basalt stone, 9 x 9 x 3 ins., lying in the center of a mound of stone, indistinctly marked. Reset the stone in a mound of stone, <math>2\frac{1}{2}</math> ft. base, <math>1\frac{1}{2}</math> ft. high.</p> <p>Land, gently rolling. Soil, alkaline clay. No timber; undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale and salt grass.</p>

	<p>Reestablishment of the Survey Executed by E. B. Monroe, Deputy Surveyor, in 1869.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">-----</p> <p>Note: This line was originally surveyed as a common boundary, but due to excessive discrepancies in the original measurements the corners as originally established will no longer serve for T. 16 N., R. 60 E. Therefore, the new monuments at all recovered and proportionate corner positions are marked for secs. of T. 16 N., R. 59 E. only.</p> <p>From the standard corner of Ts. 16 N., Rs. 59 and 60 E.</p> <p>N. 0° 57' W., along the E. bdy. of sec. 36, T. 16 N., R. 59 E.</p> <p>Over very gently rolling valley land of Jake's Valley, through low undergrowth.</p>
