

Dependent Resurvey, East Boundary, T. 17 N., R. 59 E.

Chains

from which

Fence corner, from which fences run W. and S., bears S. 78° 40' W., 9.25 chs. dist.

Land, gently rolling.

Soil, gravelly loam.

No timber; undergrowth, low rabbit brush and sagebrush.

N. 0° 19' E., on the E. bdy. of sec. 1.

Over gently rolling land draining to the SE., through low undergrowth.

The original E. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 1, which is marked by an old mound of earth and two old pits N. and S. of the corner.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 36 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

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Dig pits, 18 x 18 x 12 ins., N. and S. of post, 3 ft. dist., and raise a flat mound of earth around the iron post.

The closing corner of Ts. 17 and 18 N., R. 60 E., described in the field notes of the Independent Resurvey of the South Boundary of T. 18 N., R. 60 E.

The original corner of Ts. 17 and 18 N., R. 59 E., which is marked by an old mound of earth, the remains of four old pits, and rotted pieces of an old juniper post with some indistinct scribe markings visible.

At the corner point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

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Dig a circular trench, 5 ft. diam., 1 ft. deep and raise a flat mound of earth around the iron post.
