

## Independent Resurvey of the South Boundary, T. 19 N., R. 60 E.

Chains

- 53.50 Wash, 10 lks. wide, 6 ft. deep; drains S. 30° W.
- 53.76 Unimproved road, bears N. 30° E. and S. 30° W.
- 72.24 Intersect the E. bdy. of T. 18 N., R. 59 E., at a point 9.67 chs. S. 0° 37' W. of the cor. of Tps. 18 and 19 N., Rs. 59 and 60 E.; mkd. by an iron post, conforming to the record. I change the markings on this cor. to refer to Tps. 18 and 19 N., R. 59 E. only.

At the point of intersection

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a collar of stone, at the closing cor. of Tps. 18 and 19 N., R. 60 E., with brass cap mkd.

A juniper, 5 ins. diam., bears N. 35° 30' E., 29 lks. dist., mkd. T19N R60E S31 CC BT.

A juniper, 4 ins. diam., bears S. 62° 45' E., 9 lks. dist., mkd. T18N R60E S6 CC BT.

Land, rolling hills.

Soil, sandy to rocky clay loam.

Timber, pinon and juniper.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, shadscale, weeds and grass.

## Independent Resurvey of the South Boundary, T. 20 N., R. 60 E.

Independent resurvey superseding the survey executed by E. B. Monroe, Deputy Surveyor, in 1869. No evidence of original survey found.

Beginning at the cor. of Tps. 19 and 20 N., Rs. 60 and 61 E., mkd. by an iron post, 3 ins. diam., conforming to the record.

West, bet. secs. 1 and 36.

Over mountainous land, through scattered timber and medium dense undergrowth; desc. over W. slope.

- 3.95 Small draw, drains SE.; asc. along SE. slope.
- 17.00 Spur, projects SW.; desc. along W. slope.
- 24.00 Wash, 30 lks. wide, 6 ft. deep, drains N. 30° W.; asc. along NE. slope.
- 40.00 Point for the ¼ sec. cor. of secs. 1 and 36.
- Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 22 ins. in the ground, and in a collar of stone, with brass cap mkd.
