

## Dependent Resurvey of the Fourth Standard Parallel North in R. 60 E.

Chains

71.40 Low spur, projects S.; desc. along SW. slope.

80.10 Point for the standard cor. of Tps. 21 N., Rs. 59 and 60 E., at proportionate dist.; there is no remaining evidence of the original cor.

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 15 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit broken glass at the base of the iron post.

From the standard township cor., the original standard cor. of secs. 32 and 33, T. 21 N., R. 59 E., mkd. by a juniper stake, 2 ins. square and 3 ft. long, set in the ground, and in a mound of stone, mkd. SC TXXIN RLIXE SXXXIII on the NE. face, with faint scribe marks on the NW. face, bears S. 89° 59' W., 320.40 chs. dist.

At the cor. point

Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2½ ins. diam., 13 ins. in the ground to solid rock, and in a mound of stone, with brass cap mkd.

A juniper, 2 ins. diam., bears S. 53°09' E., 47 lks. dist., mkd. BT only.

A juniper, 8 ins. diam., bears S. 40°41' W., 134 lks. dist., mkd. BT only.

No suitable bearing trees available to the N. of line.

From this cor., the original standard cor. of secs. 31 and 32, T. 21 N., R. 59 E., mkd. by a limestone, 14x8x5 ins., firmly set in the ground and mkd. with one groove on W. face and five grooves on E. face, bears N. 89° 59' W., 79.88 chs. dist., and from the latter cor. station "Purple" of the U.S. Coast and Geodetic Survey bears S. 41°11' 45" E., 25.93 chs. dist. and its geographic position is Latitude 39°38'09.730" N., Longitude 115° 21' 16.297" W.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, gravelly to rocky clay loam.

Timber, juniper and pinon.

Undergrowth, sagebrush, bitter brush, weeds and grass.
