GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The land in T. 20 N., R. 61 E. covered by this resurvey is a nearly level bottom of Butte Valley, with a slight drainage to the northwest. The soil over most of the area is deep heavy clay, containing some sand in the southern part. There is no living water in the area.

The vegetation consists of sagebrush, shadscale, greasewood, weeds and grass. The area is chiefly valuable for grazing, but with the development of water from wells, would be ideal for farming.
