

## Dependent Resurvey of a Portion of the N. Bdy., T. 22 N., R. 55 E.

Chains

Deposit the old cor. stone at the base and raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base, 14 ins. high, around the iron post.

Land, rolling and rolling mountainous.

Soil, rocky clay.

No timber; undergrowth, sagebrush, and native grasses.

Survey of a Portion of the North Bdy., T. 22 N., R. 55 E.

From the cor. of secs. 2, 3, 34 and 35, hereinbefore described.

West, bet. secs. 3 and 34.

Asc. 40 ft. over mountainous land, on a SE. slope, through scattering undergrowth.

9.90 Winding ravine, dry, course SE. from W.; asc. 190 ft. along ravine.

40.00 Point for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor. of secs. 3 and 34.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

Raise a mound of stone, 2 ft. base,  $1\frac{1}{2}$  ft. high, N. of cor.

47.10 Leave ravine, course East from N.  $80^\circ$  W.; asc. 400 ft. along a S. slope; enter scattering timber.

75.00 Ridge, bears NE. and SW.; asc. 70 ft. over top of ridge.

80.00 Point for the cor. of secs. 3, 4, 33 and 34.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 8 ins. in the ground to bedrock, with brass cap mkd.

Deposit a limestone, 5 x 4 x 4 ins., mkd. X, at the base and raise a supporting mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 28 ins. high, around the iron post.

No suitable accessory.

Land, mountainous.

Soil, rocky.

Timber, juniper and pine; undergrowth, sagebrush.

West, bet. secs. 4 and 33.

Asc. 80 ft. over rough mountainous land, on NE. slope, with broken cliffs, and through scattering timber and undergrowth.

3.60 Leave NE. slope; asc. 30 ft. along a N. slope.

8.80 Leave N. slope; asc. 430 ft. over a NE. slope.
