A juniper, 8 ins. diam., bears S. $74\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$ W., 90 lks. dist.,
mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S 12 B T.

- 43.70 Wash, course S. 75° W.; road, bears N. 75° E. and S. 75° W.; asc. 30 ft. over a S. slope.
- 47.90 Spur, slopes S. 75° W.; desc. 40 ft. over a N. slope.
- 50.70 Wash, 15 lks. wide, course N. 80° W.; asc. 170 ft. over a SE. slope.
- 63.70 Spur, slopes S. 15° W.; desc. 90 ft. along a broken W. slope.
- 75.36 Foot of descent, bears E. and W.; asc. 10 ft. over a S. slope.
- 80.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 6 ins. in the ground, upon a cross on bedrock (X) and in a mound of stone to top, for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12, with brass cap mkd.

- 1.40 Spur, slopes N. 80° W.; desc. 80 ft. over a N. slope.
- 6.50 Wash, 10 lks. wide, course S. 75° W.; asc. 70 ft. over a S. slope.
- 12.50 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 140 ft. over a N. slope.
- 19.10 Wash, 40 lks. wide, course W.; asc. 80 ft. over a S. slope.
- 26.30 Spur, slopes W.; desc. 70 ft. along a broken W. slope.
- 40.00 Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 4 ins. in the ground upon a cross (X) on bedrock, and in a mound of stone to top, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
