Land, gently rolling.

GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The character of the land included in this township varies from nearly level desert to broken mountainous. The main portion being generally rolling to broken around the perimeter and mountainous in the central part of the township.

The soil varies over the township from fine sandy alkaline silt on the flatlands to almost entirely rocky on the mountainous areas.

Most of the township is covered with undergrowth, such as sage, rabbit brush and greasewood on the lower rolling and flat areas with black brush, manzanita, oak, sage and rabbit brush on the mountainous areas. Scattering stands of juniper, pinon and Jeffrey pine are also found on the hilly and mountainous areas, especially on the north slopes.

Most of the area of this township is suitable for stock grazing purposes.

Patented mineral claims MS No. 4218A., Shamrock, Columbia, Viola No. 2 and Viola lodes, Viola Mining District are situated in unsurveyed sections 9, 10, 15 and 16. Patented Mill Site, MS. No. 4218B is situated in unsurveyed section 3 of this township. These claims are tied to U. S. Mineral Monument No. 249. which is situated near the center of SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of unsurveyed section 10.

An access road to the above mining properties comes into the area from the west from Leith, Nevada.
