	North bet. secs. 7 and 12.
	Ascend 50 ft. over gently rolling land, through scattered juniper and low brush.
4.50	Low spur, slopes S.25°E.
14.50	Small wash, course S.30°E.
26.50	Low spur, slopes S.25°E.
38.00	Enter shallow draw, course S.20°E.
40.00	Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 7 and 12.
	Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

	A juniper, 3 in. fork, bears N.20 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 122 lks. dist., mkd. BT.
	A juniper, 6 ins. diam., bears S.23 $\frac{1}{4}$ °W., 104 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S12 BT.
	Raise a collar of stone around iron post.
	Ascend 40 ft. along shallow draw.
40.30	Wash, 10 lks. wide, course S.20°E.
52.00	Leave draw, ascend 120 ft. over gradual W. slope.
80.00	Point for the cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12.
	Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, $2\frac{1}{2}$ ins. diam., 20 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.
	T8S R69E R70E S 1   S 6 S 12   S 7 1953
	raise a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, around post to top.
	Land, slightly rolling and broken.
	Soil, rocky.
	Timber, very scattered juniper; undergrowth, blackbrush and cacti.
	North, bet. secs. 1 and 6.
	Ascend 55 ft. over SW. slope.
9.00	Low ridge, bears N.30°W. and S.30°E. Descend 130 ft. over NE. slope.
11.85	Roadway, fair, bears S.20°E. and N.30°W., along top of ridge.
