	Bury a lava stone, 5 x 4 x 3 ins., marked + alongside iron post, and raise a flat mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top.
	From this point the cor. of Ts. 5 S., Rs. 70 and 71 E., established in 1922 under Group 95, bears S.89°55'W., 3.84 chs. dist., and is marked by an iron post, 3 ins. diam., set 18 ins. above a mound of stone, 3 ft. base, 1 ft. high.
	Re-set this monument 12 ins. in the ground, to bedrock, and in a supporting mound of stone, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, to top,
