Chains	<p>N. 89° 56.5' W., bet. secs. 6 and 31.</p> <p>Over mountainous land, through scattered timber and dense brush.</p> <p>Asc. 35 ft. along S. slope.</p> <p>4.00 Wash, 20 lks. wide, course S. 70° E. Asc. 1000 ft. to ridge.</p> <p>6.60 Ravine, course NE. about 1 chain to junction with ravine from NW.</p> <p>31.30 Ridge, crest of Meadow Valley Range, bears S. and NE. Descend 160 ft. over W. slope.</p> <p>40.00 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31.</p> <p>Set an iron post, 30 ins. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.</p> <div style="text-align: center;"> $\frac{1}{4} \begin{array}{l} \text{S } 31 \\ \hline \text{S } 6 \\ 1953 \end{array}$ </div> <p>from which</p> <p>A pine, 14 ins. diam., bears N. 59$\frac{1}{4}$° E., 115 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S31 BT.</p> <p>A pine, 10 ins. diam., bears S. 70$\frac{1}{2}$° E., 73 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S6 BT.</p> <p>Raise a flat mound of stone, 3 ft. base, to top of post.</p> <p>From this corner the U.S.C. & G.S. triangulation station "Sawmill" bears S. 32° 32' E., 30.25 chs. dist., and is marked with a regulation bronze disc, set in surface rock. A triangular wooden frame, filled with rock, is erected over this station. The monument occupies the highest peak of the mountain range, at a point where the divide changes course abruptly from West to North.</p> <p>Descend slightly.</p> <p>40.60 Wash, 10 lks. wide, course N. Ascend 35 ft.</p> <p>44.30 Spur, slopes NW. Descend 410 ft. over SW. slope, through scattered pine and dense brush.</p> <p>74.20 Wash, 10 lks. wide, course N. 60° W.
