From this Utah CC, the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 26, T.40S., R20W., S.L.M., bears S.0°19'E., 40.28 chs. dist., and is marked by an iron post, 1 in. diam., 6 ins. above a mound of stone, 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ ft. base, 36 ins. high, with brass cap additionally marked 1953; so it now reads

From this Utah $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. the 281 mile monument bears S.0°19'E. 14.11 chs. dist., and is marked by an iron post, 2 ins. diam., supported in a mound of stone; alongside is the original mon. a juniper stake, 4 ins. sq. 4 ft. high, faintly mkd.

Re-set this monument 14 ins. in the ground, to bedrock, and in a mound of stone, 4 ft. base, to top, with brass cap additionally marked for amended monument, so that it now reads

Bury a granite stone 8 x 6 x 3 ins., marked + alongside the iron post. (The original stake is re-set alongside the iron post.)

Land, broken and rolling.
Soil, sandy and rocky.
Timber, scattered juniper; undergrowth, sage, cacti and joshua.

Over rolling mountainous land, through dense brush. Desc. 100 ft. over E. slope.

10.10 Wash, 10 lks. wide, course S.30°E.

10.90 Wash, 10 lks. wide, course S. Asc. 120 ft.

13.80 Ridge-spur, bears SE. Desc. 100 ft. over E. to NE. slope.
