40.91 Point for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of secs. 6 and 31. N. 11 lks. from the tangent, at proportionate distance; there is no remaining evidence of the original corner.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with brass cap mkd.

80.51 The cor. of Tps. 42 and 43 N., Rs. 22 and 23 E., N. 14 lks. from the tangent; which is marked by a granite stone, 12x10x5 ins., set in the center of a mound of stone, and mkd. with 6 notches on 3 sides and indistinct markings on 1 side.

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 3 ins. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with original cor. monument at base, with brass cap mkd.
