GENERAL DESCRIPTION

The E. and the fractional N. bdy. of T. 44 N., R. 26 E., form a part of the boundaries of the Charles Sheldon Antelope Range.

The land is generally rolling mountainous, with no timber, and only a fair undergrowth of 1 to 2 ft. sagebrush, with widely scattering patches of native grass, the latter affording from fair to poor grazing.

There is no water and there are no settlers.
