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## Chains

43.50 Draw, drains S.80°E. 8 chs. thence southerly; asc. 170 ft. over broken E. slope.

67.00 Divide between Goose Creek and Fall Creek, bears S. 1 ch. to peak and N.60°E.

69.55 Construction road, unimproved, bears NE. and SW., desc. 160 ft. over W. slope.

80.22 The cor. of secs. 1, 6, 7 and 12 on the W. bdy. of the Tp.

Land, mountainous.  
Soil, gravelly to rocky loam, 2nd to 4th rate.  
Timber, scattering small aspen; undergrowth, sagebrush, deerbrush, chokecherry, serviceberry, laurel.  
Grazing, very good.

From the cor. of secs. 5, 6, 7 and 8,

N. 12° 16' W., bet. secs. 5 and 6,

Asc. 200 ft. over a broken S. slope thru medium dense low undergrowth.

17.20 Spur ridge, bears E. and W. 5 chs. thence N., desc. 100 ft. over N. slope.

23.02 Proportionate distance; no trace was found of the original  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor.,  
Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 28 ins. in the ground, and in a circular mound of stones, 4 ft. diam., to top of post, for the  $\frac{1}{4}$  sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.
