DEPENDENT RESURVEY OF SUBDIVISION OF T. 20 N., R. 19 E.

Chains	S.30°W.; desc. 380 ft. along a broken, steep N. and NW. slope.
35.00	Base of steep NW. slope; continue over gentle W. slope.
39.96	The cor. of secs. 1, 2, 11 and 12.  Land, mountainous. Soil, shallow sandy to coarse rocky loam, 3rd rate. Undergrowth, sagebrush, buck brush. Timber, juniper. Grazing, good.
	N. 0°14' W., bet. secs. 1 and 2, (south half mile.)  Over broken hilly land through medium dense undergrowth and medium heavy small timber; asc. over gentle SW. slope.
13.70	Draw, drains SW.
22.40	Draw, drains SW.; asc. 100 ft. over broken S. slope.
32.20	Spur ridge, bears W. from N.70°E., spur slopes S.15°E.; desc. 100 ft. over broken N. slope.
38.50	Dim mine road, bears E. and W.
38.80	Intersect the original $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., which is a granite stone, 6x10 x16 ins., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ on W. face, firmly set in a small mound of stones.  At point for cor.,  Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 1 in. diam., 30 ins. in the ground, with the original corner stone deposited at the base, for the $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor., with brass cap mkd.  <div style="text-align: center;"><math>\frac{1}{4}</math> S 2   S 1 1942</div> from which,  A juniper, 4 ins. diam., bears N.79 $\frac{1}{2}$ °E., 83 lks. dist., mkd. $\frac{1}{4}$ S1 BT. 8.70	Old road, bears N.72°E. and S.85°W.
38.40	Shallow draw, drains N.80°E.; asc. S. slope 10 ft.
39.17	Intersect the Fourth Std. Parallel North at the remonumented closing cor. of secs. 1 and 2, an iron post, 2 ins. diam., set, mkd, witnessed as described in the field notes of the resurvey of the S. bdy. of T. 21 N., R. 19 E., executed under this group.  From this closing cor., The Std. cor. of secs. 35 and 36, bears West, 8.37 chs. dist. The Std. $\frac{1}{4}$ sec. cor. of sec. 36 bears East, 31.99 chs. dist.  Land, rolling and broken hilly. Soil, gravelly clay loam, 2nd and 3rd rate. Undergrowth, sagebrush, buck brush.
