## Chains

At point for cor.,

Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 26 ins. in the ground, for std. cor. of secs. 31 and 32, with brass cap mkd.

raise a mound

of stone, 3 ft. base, 2 ft. high, N. of cor.

Land, rolling and hilly. Soil, very shallow coarse rocky clay loam, 3rd rate. Undergrowth, sagebrush, buck brush, serviceberry. Timber, scrubby mahogany, yellow pine. Grazing, good.

S. 89°50' W., along the S. bdy. of sec. 31,

Over rolling and hilly land through very dense tall undergrowth. Desc. gentle W. slope.

Intersect the California-Nevada state boundary line and point for the 15.74 closing cor. of secs. 6 and 31, Ts. 20 and 21 N., R. 18 E.

> Set an iron post, 3 ft. long, 2 ins. diam., 24 ins. in the ground, with the original closing cor. stone deposited at the base, for closing cor. of secs. 6 and 31, with brass cap mkd.

raise a mound

of stone, 4 ft. base, 1 ft. high, around post.

The original closing cor. monument, a granite rock 5x6x18 ins., mkd. I groove on W. face, 6 grooves on S. face, was found lying on surface of ground, out of position, without identifying accessories, South 21 lks. dist. This rock was deposited at the base of the iron post cor.

From the closing cor., Mile Post No. 163 on the state bdy bears S. 0°13' W., 8.96 chs.

Mile Post No. 162, bears N. 0°13' E., 71.06 chs. dist. Brick chimney of Flynn's dwelling bears N. 29°31' W. Flag pole at Highway Maintenance station on U. S. Highway No.

95 bears N. 11°27' W. U.S. Forest lookout station "Babbitt" bears S. 67°26' W. Flag pole at above station bears S. 67°30' W.

Thence, on blank line, along the S. bdy, of sec. 31 in California.

Record distance; no trace of the original std. \( \frac{1}{4} \) sec. cor. of sec. 31 40.00 was found. This cor. is not reestablished by me.

Intersect the original std. cor. of T. 21  $^{\rm N}$ .,Rs. 17 and 18 E., which is a basalt stone, 4x8x30 ins., mkd. 6 notches on NE. and SE. edges, firmly set in a mound of stone. I reset this stone in the center of 78.82 a rebuilt mound, 7 ft. diam., 2 ft. high.
